****** Asynchronous sessions are windows of time during which students can complete independent work assigned by the teachers. On Wednesdays, high school students will receive approximately 60 minutes of asynchronous learning per period, for a total of 180 minutes. On Wednesdays, MS/JH students will receive approximately 30 minutes per period of assignments and 90 minutes of other asynchronous work such as iReady, reading, intervention, etc., for a total of 180 minutes. These assignments can be completed later in the day as convenient for students and parents, as long as the student meets each teacher’s specific deadlines for submission.
